Approaches

Partnership approaches

- Design of the project between a consortium of humanitarian (SI), development (GRET) and capitalization support (Groupe URD) NGOs in partnership with ONEA
- Development of partnerships with municipalities
- A preliminary phase of participatory construction of the program
- Work with the WASH Cluster and other humanitarian and development NGOs

Diagnoses

- Joint technical diagnosis with ONEA to determine needs
- Diagnosis of the governance of drinking water services
- Several in-depth studies: socio-anthropological, hydrogeological

Planning

- Concerted Emergency Master Plan

Some solutions identified in a concerted manner



Technical solutions

- **Improvement of production:** connections of unexploited or underutilized boreholes (PMH/PEA), treatment of borehole water contaminated with Arsenic
- **Securing functional boreholes :** solarization/electrification, remote management
- **Reinforcement of distribution** through extensions, standpipes (Séguénéga, Ouahigouya and Kongoussi)

Some solutions identified in a concerted manner

Organizational solutions

- **Articulation with humanitarian actors** to take charge of purely emergency actions in our areas of intervention (Titao)
- Support to ONEA and municipalities for the **coordination of humanitarian action in their areas**
- Support for ONEA to **maintain the drinking water service** in the municipality of Titao through UNAS flights (diesel supply)
- Support to municipalities for the implementation of **transitional management systems** for all newly built structures and those whose management mode is not formal

Some identified solutions

Institutional Solutions

- ONEA's resilience plan in the face of the crisis (capacity building plan)
- 5 municipal capacity building plans

Capitalization

- Research-action to improve our practices: consideration of IDPs, financial viability of services
- Interactive assessment with mini-seminar (EIMS)
- Capitalization of approaches for dissemination

Opportunities/challenges



- Maintain service and a capacity for action in areas with very high security challenges
- Flexibility of donors in the face of volatile situations in certain areas (non-dedicated financing lines)
- Means for institutions to better coordinate humanitarian action and development
