Who we are..




- Water for People is an international NGO based in the U.S.A.
- Vision: a world where all people have access to safe drinking water and sanitation, a world where no one suffers or dies from water – or sanitation – related

Background

- According to June 2020 and June 2021 MWE Sector performance reports functionality of rural water supplies was at 85%. (water and environment sector performance report by Ministry of Water and Environment). Why the stagnation?
- Kamwenge District Functionality rate is at 62%.
- Luuka District Functionality rate is at 76%

The National Operation and Maintenance Framework proposes Handpump Mechanic Associations as Service providers alongside Umbrella of water and Sanitation and National Water and Sewerage corporation.

Roles of Handpump mechanics as area service providers:



Handpump mechanics support water user committees by repairing pumps upon breakdown.

As an area service provider the Pump Mechanic enters into a repair contract with the water committee to make any major repairs needed on the borehole. (one off)

Or the Hand Pump mechanics get into a Service Contract, with the Water and Sanitation Committee for a full year to conduct routine checks and preventive maintenances every 3 months (4 times a year)

What led to the interventions in our focus area



At baseline

- Delayed repair time (89% of the sources has broken down and not repaired with a day)
- Functionality (10% of the sources had no drinking water on the day of visit)

Interventions:



- Capacity Building sessions for the Hand Pump Mechanics.
- Supporting the association with tool kits for maintenance/repairs
- **Establishment of hardware shops**

Achievements:

- Spare part network with fast moving spare parts created
- Reduced downtime of boreholes (41% had quick response time)
- Improved coordination and accountability with the district.

Linkages in the supply chain/functionality of water sources



Challenges faced in strengthening the system

- Low enforcement of the operation and maintenance framework which calls for payment of water user fees by all users.
- Low community willingness to pay water user fees
- Non functionality of water and sanitation committees.

Recommendations


